

An example of a Competency Standard in the Drilling Industry is:

DRT NH 03 A – Mobilise Equipment and Materials

The code numbers indicate: the industry – DRT (Drilling); the sector of the industry – NH (non-hydrocarbons; the edition - 03 A (2003 first edition)

One **element** of this competency standard is: 3.1 – Prepare for move to site.

In order to prove that the driller can competently perform this element the Assessor would be assessing their ability to meet the following **performance criteria**:

- 1.1 Observe safety rules and regulations including site rules, safety safety plans and site specific instructions
- 1.2 Check operational safety by carrying out pre-start inspection procedures according to manufacturer's specifications, company and/or site requirements.
- 1.3 Receive, interpret and clarify briefing details in accordance with requirements.
- 1.4 Prepare vehicle, vehicle kit, camping equipment, first aid kit, survival kit and personal equipment for remote assignment, as required.

The Range of Variables for this standard would be:

Vehicles may include:

- any two-wheel drive passenger vehicle
- A-all-wheel drive sedan/utility/station wagon
- light trucks (usually table tops)
- heavy support vehicles
- heavy vehicles (drill rig)
- towed vehicle trailer

Note: State legislative requirements on road transport are adhered to.

The Evidence Guide in this example suggests that critical aspects of evidence to be considered are:

- State legislative requirements on road transport are adhered to
- Prescribed driving licences are mandatory in completion of this unit
- Safety codes of practice and skills needed to address:
 - hazardous working conditions
 - ability to drive in a range of conditions
 - recommended vehicle loadings
 - security aspects of loads on vehicles
 - on and off-road driving techniques
 - stall recovery
 - site personnel safety
 - industrial safety regulations and legislation as expressed by policies and procedures
 - workplace policies on vehicle usage
